Countrystyle Wins Kent Commercial Services Contract

Countrystyle Recycling has been appointed by Commercial Services Ltd (a Kent County Council wholly owned trading company) as the waste haulage and plant hire service provider for two waste transfer stations in Kent, North Farm at Tunbridge Wells and Dunbrik at Sevenoaks.

The four year contract, worth c. £6 million across the life of the agreement commenced on 1st April 2015 and sees Countrystyle manage the waste haulage for over 116,000 tonnes of material per year including wood, dry mixed recyclables, green waste, soil and rubble, glass, plasterboard, asbestos and domestic bulky waste. Countrystyle also takes over responsibility for operating plant at each site for loading vehicles for off site haulage.

The materials will be collected by Countrystyle's own artic fleet and transported to various treatment and disposal sites, including Countrystyle's own recycling facility at Ridham, nr Sittingbourne, Kent.

Countrystyle Expands Paper Recycling Service in the South East



Countrystyle has secured contracts with three major South East-based print companies to provide recycling services that aim to improve the sustainability of the printing operations of each of these companies.

Headley Brothers (Ashford), Pureprint Group (Uckfield) and Mastercolour (Tunbridge Wells) have appointed Countrystyle to recycle a variety of waste materials from their premises, including all grades of paper, cardboard, plastic and wood. Countrystyle is providing dedicated recycling containers and compactors to each company to make the collection and recycling process as efficient and simple as possible.

Headley Brothers, Pureprint Group and Mastercolour each operate environmentally sustainable printing businesses that aim to reduce the environmental impact of printing. The role of Countrystyle, in providing efficient collection services and sourcing end-destination recycling solutions, is critical to promoting each company's 'green credentials'.







Countrystyle takes the Lead in Reducing Fire Risk

As part of Countrystyle's application to amend its waste wood processing permit at its site at Ridham Sea Terminals, Countrystyle has invested heavily in ensuring that its new processed wood storage area follows the guidance issued by the Environment Agency (TGN7.01) and the WISH Forum on reducing fire risk at Waste and Recycling Sites.

Storage bunkers constructed from fire resistent concrete blocks are being erected on a dedicated 2 acre site, which will incorporate an integrated fire and dust suppression system as well as stockpile temperature and integrated CCTV monitoring capability.



Kent Fire & Rescue Service



As part of its extensive planning and consultation process prior to submission, Countrystyle obtained prior approval to its integrated fire managment system from Kent Fire & Rescue Service. Stuart Butler-Gallie, Director of Legal & Admin, said "the approach taken by the Company, as a key player in the waste wood processing market, to planning future investment in its processes, demonstrates our committiment to being at the forefront of compliance in a difficult operating environment."

Trade Waste Expansion requires Fleet Upgrade



To ensure our continued committment to a quality service for trade waste customers as part of Countrystyle's Fleet Replacement Programme and as part of growth plans, the Company takes delivery of three new Mercedes Arocs dustcarts in May 2015 with a further six deliveries scheduled between August and September 2015. This takes Countrystyle's trade waste fleet to 19 and its total fleet of all vehicles to 100.

The new Mercedes dustcarts will provide additional flexibility to trade waste rounds operating in the Ashford and Margate areas in Kent and will enable expansion of Countrystyle's collection services in areas centred on Crovdon, Bromley, Epsom and Redhill

The new trade vehicles boast a number of features that improve efficiency and reduce the Company's carbon footprint. The Mercedes dustcarts come with a light-weight chassis which along with the new Euro 6 engine reduces fuel consumption. The vehicles also come with a new Fleetboard Eco Support system which offers the driver tips on their driving to improve vehicle efficiency and reduce environmental impact.

MRW National Recycling Awards 2015

DS Smith in partnership with Countrystyle have been shortlisted as one of the finalist for the Waste Prevention award catergory at this year's MRW National Recycling Awards taking place at the Hilton Hotel, Park Lane, London on the 1st July 2015.

DS Smith operate the second biggest recovered fibre based paper operation in Europe, Kemsley Mill in Kent. Working in partnership, Countrystyle is now able to recycle 12,000tpa of Ragger Rope. These ropes are a by-product of the paper pulping process. They consist of metal wire, which is continually pulled through the pulper to remove contaminants from the paper pulp such as plastic. The Ragger Ropes were previously sent to landfill.



Countrystyle Cleaning Up Kent Cricket

Countrystyle has joined forces with Kent County Cricket Club in promoting access to cricket activities, countywide.

Countrystyle, is the first business in the county's history to have a direct association with Kent Cricket's Community Department, as a Major Sponsor for the next three years. Countrystyle will also be managing all the waste collection and recycling of dry mixed recyclables, glass, green and general waste at The Spitfire Ground, St Lawrence, Canterbury and the County Ground, Beckenham.





Kent Cricket's community department worked with 117 schools in 2014, involving 2,183 hours of staff time. The team conducted 115 teacher training sessions, were linked to over 3,000 formal and informal cricket matches and had contact with 41,867 school pupils. Its portfolio of work includes support for 320 affiliated clubs including 180 junior sections and 64,000 players annually.

Kent Cricket CEO Jamie Clifford said: "It is very encouraging to have local businesses recognise and invest in our community work. This is often the unglamorous and little-known activities we do and yet it affects thousands of school children and adults throughout Kent".
